

## PAST SIMPLE-PAST CONTINUOUS WHEN/WHILE



<u>Exceptions:</u> There are some verbs that we **DON'T** use in the past continuous tense. Because they aren't action verbs.

e.g.: like, love, hate, smell, seem, believe, understand, realise, belong, know, want, need, depend, suppose ... >>>>>> NO PAST CONTINUOUS FORM!
